The House of Peace was founded in 1968 by Br. Booker Ashe, O.F.M., Capuchin and Fr. Matthew Gottschalk, O.F.M., Capuchin. We are located on the corner of 17th and Walnut Streets in the City of Milwaukee.

Following the example of St. Francis of Assisi, we operate a food pantry, clothes closet and provide counseling. The House of Peace also hosts the UW-M College of Nursing-HOP Nursing Clinic and the Marquette Volunteer Legal Clinic.

Staff and volunteers serve the needy by offering a Teen Program, Women's Empowerment Classes and offering space for local community groups to meet.
